



Location:

The 16 hectares (17.5 acres) vineyard is located on the third terrace located at the northern end of the village of Albas which overlooks the Lot River from an altitude of 100 metres.

TERTRE PERDIGOUS derives from a vineyard established on a hillock gravely with a gravely, clayey-chalky soil.

Varietal composition:

Malbec 80%
Merlot 20%

Vinification:

The harvest is carefully sorted out and totally de-stemmed. The maceration, at controlled temperature, lasts about 2 weeks during which sequential pumping-over and punching of the cap are carried out. After completion of the alcoholic fermentation, the wine is **aged for 12 months before it is bottled.**

The wine:

- Dark ruby robe with crimson hues.
- On the nose, aromas of small **red and black fruits** breathe out first.
- When aerated, **scents of soft spice and fines leather** exhale.
- Supple and well-balanced wine on the palate with predominant **fruity aromas.**
- Fleshy and velvety texture with **well coated tannins.**

Serve at 17°C. Ready for drinking now but can be **laid down for 5 to 7 years** after the harvest
